WGN's John Williams visits Mill Race Inn

John Williams, midday host of WGN News/Talk 720, entertained a standing-room only crowd during a live broadcast from Geneva's Mill Race Inn Feb. 29.

Williams chatted with the audience, and took listener phone calls between radio interviews with U.S. Sen. Dick Durbin and others during his broadcast, which aired from 1 to 4 p.m.

Williams' appearance was part of the radio station's Hometown Voices tour presented by Jewel-Osco. WGN radio is owned

by the Tribune company which also owns Triblocal.

Williams and Steve Bertrand, midday news anchor at the radio station, also interviewed Sam Hill, a Geneva alderman, and Bill Foster and Jim Oberweis, congressional candidates who face each other in a March 8 special election in Illinois' 14th District.

Jewel-Osco also named Geneva resident Dave Dorman as their Hometown Hero for the Geneva stop of the Hometown Voices tour.
